1. Discipline and Punctuality

- Attend all classes, seminars, and college activities regularly and on time.
- Follow the academic calendar and respect deadlines for assignments and examinations.
- Late arrivals and absenteeism without valid reason will not be tolerated.

2. Respect and Behavior

- Show respect towards teachers, staff, and fellow students at all times.
- Maintain polite and courteous behavior within and outside the college campus.
- Use respectful language and avoid any form of rude, offensive, or abusive speech or conduct.

3. Dress Code

- Students must dress modestly and appropriately as per college norms.
- ID cards should be worn at all times within the campus.

5. Cleanliness and Environment
